In addition to holding Meeting for Worship each First Day and Meeting for Worship with a Concern for Business at 12:30 p.m. on the first First Day of each Month, Flushing Meeting is host to an Interfaith Breakfast at 8:30 a.m. on the first First Day of each month. Two members of the meeting also participated in an Interfaith Dialog for a film about the remonstrance and freedom of religion in the present.
