During January, February, and March 2022 Fifteenth Street held Meetings for Worship each First Day: **9:30 am** the meetings were in-person, with safety protocols in effect; **11:00 am** the meetings were on zoom, with hybrid meetings (with safety protocols) beginning February 20th. **Joint Worship** - held the 1st First Day of each quarter at 9:30 am Manhattan Meeting and 11 am Fifteenth Street - was held on 4/3/22. **First Day School** was on hold, with occasional gatherings in the courtyard. In-person first day school resumed whenever we had in-person (hybrid) worship at 11.
